Also, on that date (Saturday, June 19th) I'll have to vacate my room for another student who is expected to arrive for summer school.

Therefore, I have a pretty full week ahead and won't know definitely whether I'll find work

or come home. However, working prospects are good. There is a shortage of domestic help here in Ann Arbor and wages are good - 15 per week and up. Common labor on some of the campus building projects pays 5 per day. But, before settling on anything specifically, I wish to run over to Detroit and see Snow F. Briggsby (I am enclosing a clipping with reference to him). ~~He~~ I met him over there in November and have corresponded with him constantly ever since. He has some inside "pulls" and may be able to get me a position. Then too, the N. A. C. P. convention will be held in Detroit June 29th and I'd like to meet some of the "Big Shots" and see what they can do about further school finance as I have another half year

before getting my Master's
degree.

So, I figured that what I asked
for would be about what I'd
actually need to carry out the
above plans in any sort of a
business like way.

Incidentally, a back N. Y. A.
check for \$2500 will be mailed
home about the 1st wk of July in
as much as it is doubtful that
I'll be up here to call for it in
person. So, in case I am not
