

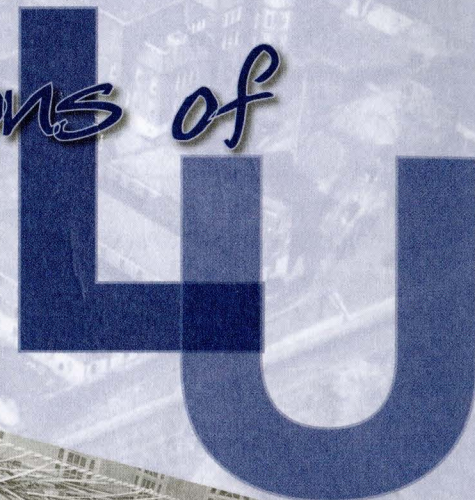

Official Housing Instructions

- The hotel(s) must receive housing forms by **September 30, 2006**.
- The hotel/motel(s) cannot accept telephone/telex reservations or online. Reservations **cannot** be made through the Office of Alumni Affairs.
- Mail or fax the Official Housing Form to your **first choice hotel/motel**. A room confirmation number will be mailed to you directly from the hotel.
- Only **one room** may be requested on each form. **Reservations will only be accepted on the Official Form or a reasonable facsimile.**
- If you fax your form, do not mail the form as well, in order to avoid duplication and possible double billing. We suggest you keep a copy of your form for your records.
- If you are sharing a room, send only one form with the names of all persons who are sharing. Be sure to include the names and ages of all children. Indicate the earliest arrival date and the latest departure date if your travel plans differ from those of other guests sharing your room.
- Rooms are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.** Please rank the remainder of the hotel/motels on the bottom of the Official Housing Form. Reservations made after **September 30, 2006** are subject to different room rates.
- All reservations require one night's deposit (excluding tax) or a credit card guarantee. Cashier's checks/money orders should be payable to the hotel. If you prefer to submit a cashier's check/money order, a minimum deposit of \$100 is required. Your deposit will be deducted from your final bill upon your departure.
- REFUND CANCELLATION POLICY: Please inquire about cancellation policy when making reservations. Return the Official Housing Form to your first hotel choice listed below. Rank in order of hotel preference.**

Parade Information & Guidelines

Homecoming Theme: *Reflections of LU*

All Floats and Decorated Vehicle entries should reflect the Homecoming Theme

GUIDELINES

1. A completed entry form must be submitted NO LATER THAN September 22, 2006.
2. All entries are required to have a visible sign that identifies the group.
3. Signage will be provided if the parade registration form is received by September 22, 2006.

PARADE ASSEMBLY

All entries should arrive by 8:30 am and must be assembled by 9:00 am in their designated area.

FLOATS: Assemble in order on Lafayette Street. Position numbers will be mailed, faxed or emailed after the registration form has been received.

BANDS: Band buses should unload along Chestnut Street. Bands are to assemble on Dawson Drive. Lincoln University Band members will meet and direct you to your position.

Drill Teams: Assemble in the parking lot of Jason Gymnasium located on Lafayette Street.

Decorated Vehicles: Assemble in the parking lot of Mitchell Hall located on Dunklin near Lafayette.

JUDGING CRITERIA

The following four entry types will be judged provided entries are submitted by September 22, 2006.

1. Bands:

- Will be judged by standard band criteria: tone quality, musicality, visual etc.
- Will perform for one (1) minute only before the judging stand located in front of the Courthouse Annex at 311 High Street.
- Must have their organization's name displayed prominently for the judges to read.

2. Drill Teams:

- Drill teams will be judged by standard drill team criteria: costuming, precision, etc.
- Will perform for one (1) minute only before the judging stand located in front of the Courthouse Annex at 311 High Street.
- Must have their organization's name displayed prominently for the judges to read.

3. Floats:

- Floats will be judged by how well the theme, "*Reflections of LU*" is depicted: originality, attractiveness, etc.
- Floats should NOT stop in front of the judging stand, but continue moving as judging is taking place.

4. Decorated Vehicles:

- Decorated vehicles will be judged by how well the theme, "*Reflections of LU*" is depicted: decorations, originality, attractiveness, etc.
- Decorated vehicles should NOT stop in front of the judging stand, but continue moving as judging is taking place.

DISTRIBUTION OF POINTS FOR FLOATS AND DECORATED VEHICLES

Up to 40 Points will be given for how well the theme, "*Reflections of LU*" is depicted.

Up to 20 Points will be given for Originality

Up to 20 Points will be given for Attractiveness

Up to 20 Points will be given for adherence to performance time regulations.

DISTRIBUTION OF POINTS FOR BANDS AND DRILL TEAMS

Up to 50 Points will be given to bands for standard band criteria: tone quality, musicality, visual etc.

Up to 50 Points will be given to drill teams for standard drill team criteria: precision, etc.

Up to 30 Points will be given for costume/appearance

Up to 20 Points will be given for adherence to performance time regulations.
